REC 2 indicates our upstairs Rec Center adjacent to the pools (used primarily for venue changes due to weather)

TENT indicates our **WORKSHOP TENT** located in front of the Main Office (adjacent to our Adult Pool Complex)

RULES & REGULATIONS

PLEASE READ

Please take a moment to read our rules & regulations on the back of our map. Make sure all members of your camping party are aware of them, especially:

****Chair policy at stage: If chair is unoccupied for more than 2 hours, any chairs located in the area nearest the stage may be moved by event staff or occupied by other campers. It is unfair to performers and festival attendees for campers to place their chairs in the front rows and only join us for certain acts. If someone is sitting in your chair, politely inform of your return****

****Wristbands must be worn at all times and displayed to any staff member upon request***

* No keg beer, drugs or open display of alcohol--No glass containers in public, including stage area

*NO BIKES OR GOLF CARTS IN STAGE AREA (Golf carts may be used to drop off passengers at the top of the hill, but due to the distraction created by headlights and "reverse signals", carts may not be parked in that area, and must proceed beyond the top of the hill to turn around without creating a disturbance).

*To avoid distracting the performers and obstructing other guests, please enter and exit between songs only, and please turn off cell phones (or set on "vibrate").

*Again for 2010, by overwhelming request, there is No Smoking on hillside seating area at stage

*No audio/video recording equipment, and no solicitation of items other than approved vendors in vendor area.

*No motorcycles may be operated beyond front gate between 4PM Thursday and 6PM Sunday.

*Relaxed Quiet Hours for SITE CAMPING will be observed from 12AM until 8AM. After hours picking by any large groups will be limited to *non-amplified* acoustics at camping in the rough. Excessively loud or unruly behavior will not be tolerated at any time.

*No walking (or carrying) of pets through the campground--No pets are permitted with any Rough Camping or with Day Visitors or rental trailers.

*All bikes and scooters must be kept off walkways, and away from stage areas. Any bikes out after dark will be locked up for the safety of our riders. The use of helmets is required for those under 18.

*Do not cut through other campsites--use roads and footpaths

*All children & teenagers must be back on their site by 11PM (those out after will be escorted back to site by security).

*All vehicles must be parked on site or in the visitor parking lot. *There is no parking at the pools, office, restrooms, or along the side of the road.* Park Speed Limit is 8MPH--SLOW DOWN!!

****FOR THOSE CAMPING IN THE ROUGH, NOTE: No pets--No groundfires*****

DO NOT DEPOSIT YOUR HIBACHI ASHES ON THE FIELD!

(A few campsites with amenities are still available--check with the office if interested in upgrading)

The only guests who are permitted vehicle access past the main gate are those with weekend passes, or those who have purchased passes for each remaining day of the event.

Horseback Trail Rides & Pony Rides: Trail Rides are for campers at least 10 years old and at least 4' 6" tall (54 inches), with a maximum weight of 220 pounds. All riders must wear a helmet (provided), and no open-toed shoes or sandals. Any child age 10, 11 or 12 must register IN PERSON in THE OFFICE with a parent or guardian to verify minimum height requirement is met. The cost of a 30 minute guided trail ride is \$20.00, and you may sign up 1 day in advance for any morning trail rides, and same-day sign-ups are taken starting at 8AM for any remaining morning rides, as well as for that day's afternoon rides if the morning rides are filled. Be sure to meet at the corral 15 minutes prior to your riding time (the temporary equestrian center is located across from the main entrance, as the new barn is under construction)—**THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR MISSED RIDES.** Management reserves the right to reschedule rides due to weather. For the younger children, pony rides are offered for those riders at least 2 years of age, and are held in the show ring across from the entrance at 12:15PM—please be on time. You may purchase your \$2.50 tickets in the office anytime before 12:00PM. Due to insurance constraints, unfortunately we cannot offer pony rides to anyone under the age of 2, nor may we put 2 riders on a horse at any time. A parent must sign pony ride waiver and assurance of age at time of purchase, and must be present at pony rides, which use our full-size horses around the ring.

Wireless Internet

Strawberry Park's "Hotspot" reception is currently available throughout the Park. Campers receive an hour of free service per day. Additional time may be purchased in the office (\$1/hr; \$5/day; \$20/week or \$30/month). The construction materials used in RVs can limit reception—you will probably receive best results at your picnic table. Please note that your free hour each day starts when you first log on, and ends 60 minutes later (not 10 minutes now, 10 minutes later in the day etc). In addition, your free hour each day begins 24 hours after your previous day's free hour has ended.

Single Stream Recycling and Separation in effect for 2010

Each arriving camper will receive two different trash bags upon registration. The black bag (or you may use your own trash bags, such as “Hefty”...as long as they are NOT CLEAR) is for true “trash”, which is simply defined as anything that is NOT included on the list of recyclables below. The CLEAR TRASH BAG is for all items that are able to be recycled. There is no need to separate the plastics from the metals from the paper etc. Please place your tied bags roadside between the hours of 8AM and 4PM daily, and Strawberry Park will take your trash AND recyclables to the appropriate dumpster. **DO NOT PLACE TRASH OUT AFTER DARK!!!** As we are located out in the country, your trash may attract various forms of wildlife, including (but not limited to) raccoons, skunks, squirrels, mice and fox. **What can be placed in the clear recycle bags?** The following items may all be placed in the same clear bag—no need to separate: Paper, rinsed plastic bottles & jugs & jars (#1-#7 plastics), newspapers, magazines & brochures, paperbacks & phone books, rinsed glass bottles & jars, metal jar lids (removed from the jar), cans, paper egg cartons, paper milk & juice cartons (remove caps), paperboard boxes, paper bags, corrugated cardboard, empty aerosol cans. **What can't go in?** Food waste (please rinse containers), bio-hazardous waste & needles, basic trash, as well as “dirty paper”, such as pizza boxes. These items should all be placed in your black trash bag. Need more bags? Just ask!

New Early Bird Reservation Opportunity!!

Make Your 2011 Cajun/Zydeco Festival Reservations Today!!

We hope you are enjoying your current stay at Strawberry Park. Many of you are familiar with trying to make reservations on January 2 of each year. To better serve our camper's request to reserve earlier, we are offering the opportunity to make reservations one year in advance. Quite simply, if you are here for a 2010 summer vacation stay from July 9 to July 16, and you wish to reserve the comparable week in 2011, you will be permitted to reserve exactly 1 year in advance of your arrival date (so you may reserve on July 10, 2010 for a July 10-17, 2011 reservation). This will be permitted for summer vacation stays, as well as for spring and fall weekends. Therefore, those campers who are camping here this weekend will be able to reserve a spot for 2011 before heading home, with the site fee due within 7 days (festival tickets can be purchased at the 2010 advance rate until November 1, 2010, by which time the headliners for 2011 will have been announced).

WEEKEND PASSES—Weekend passes are available at a cost of \$115 per person (cash only at gate). Campers may arrive anytime after 9AM Thursday. Weekend passes entitle you to join us in our rough camping area. If you are exiting & returning each day, a **WEEKEND PASS** entitles you to preferred parking within the main camping area. All other visitors will be parked in the lots across from the main entrance and shuttled to the music venues. The only guests who are permitted vehicle access past the main gate are those with weekend passes, or those who have purchased passes for each remaining day of the event.

THURSDAY GUESTS—Guests may arrive any time after 9AM on Thursday, and will be parked across from the main entrance. Cost is \$25/person, and guests must exit within 30 minutes of the final concert (approx 11PM). Any vehicles remaining in the field lot after 12:00AM will be towed at the expense of the owner, with each person charged for a Friday “day pass”.

FRIDAY GUESTS—Guests are welcome to arrive anytime after 9AM on Friday. Parking is across from the main entrance. You may remain for the entire day & evening program at the cost of \$45/person. Those arriving after 5PM will be charged \$35. Friday guests must exit the Park within 30 minutes of the final concert (approx. 11:30PM). Any vehicles remaining in the field lot after 12:00AM will be towed at the expense of the owner, with each person charged for a Saturday “day pass”. Those “day only” guests who leave before 6PM will be refunded \$10.

SATURDAY GUESTS--Guests may arrive anytime after 9AM on Saturday. Parking is across from the main entrance. You may remain for the entire day & evening program at the cost of \$45/person. Those arriving after 5PM will be charged \$35. Saturday guests must exit the Park within 30 minutes of the final concert (approx. 11:30PM). Any vehicles remaining in the field lot after 12:00AM will be towed at the expense of the owner, with each person charged for a Sunday “day pass”. Those “day only” guest who leave before 6PM will be refunded \$10.

SUNDAY GUESTS--\$30/person fee covers all music and dancing. Guests may arrive anytime after 8AM and are welcome to stay until 6:00PM.

****Overnight Option****

For those dancers too tired to drive home on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday night, we invite you to stay overnight for \$10/person. You will be charged the full fee for each remaining festival session (cash only), wristbanded for those sessions, parked within the CIR area, and refunded if you depart before the next day’s music begins (minus \$10 overnight fee).
