Single Stream Recycling & Trash Pick Up 10AM--4PM Daily--Please place your bagged & tied garbage (black bag) and all your recyclables (clear bag) at the edge of the road in front of your site. *Please do not put garbage out after dark.* For those needing an on-site pump-out, the cost is \$24 and you must sign up by 9:30AM on the day you need service (emergency pump out is \$42).

Parents please note--You are responsible for the behavior of your children and teenagers. Strawberry Park will not hesitate to evict any child or teenager behaving in a manner detrimental to the Park, with no refund or credit. Make your children aware of our rules and curfews, and help us enforce them. Thank you.

Please take a moment to read our rules & regulations on the back of our map. Make sure all members of your camping party are aware of them, especially:

- **No walking (or carrying) of pets through the campground.** Please visit our Pet Park located along Pierce Rd (pets must be transported in vehicle to Strawberry Park).
- **The use of helmets is REQUIRED for all riders under age 18. Any bikes out after dusk will be locked up overnight for the safety of our riders.** All bikes, scooters and rollerblades must be kept off walkways, basketball court and rec center, and must be back on site by dark. Bikes out after dark will be locked to bike rack overnight. Skateboard use is prohibited for insurance reasons.
- **All children & teenagers must be back on their own site by 11PM.** Any children or teenagers out after curfew (11:00PM) will be escorted back to site by security. Any kids or teens off their own site after curfew must be with a parent. Campers under 18 years of age may not smoke in any public areas. All teen events are non-smoking. After hours security phone: (860) 334-9953
- **Quiet hour begins at 11PM on weeknights & 11:30PM on weekends (Fri & Sat).** Unreasonably loud noise levels or profane language will not be tolerated at any time. Violators will be expelled without refund. No fireworks of any kind are permitted.
- **Park Speed Limit is 8 MPH--SLOW DOWN!!** All vehicles must be parked on site or in the visitor parking lot. Vehicle pass must be displayed from rear view mirror, with "Site #" side facing out. There is no parking at the pools, office, restrooms, or along the side of the roads. Permitted golf carts and electric scooters are to be driven by adults only, and quiet hour rules apply when operating carts. Golf carts are limited to unit owners and Park rentals, and may not exceed 6 occupants, all of whom must be seated completely on the seat.
- **Do not cut through other sites--use roads and footpaths.** Do not tamper with stone walls. Offending campers will be charged for needed wall repairs. No release of RV "gray water" onto the ground (use dump station or pump-out service).
- **Please read rules at swimming pools.** Children under 13 must have parent present within pool area, and no flotation devices unless USCG approved. No glass anywhere please, but especially not at the pools or rec center. All buildings and covered areas are NON-SMOKING.

Horseback Trail Rides & Pony Rides: Trail Rides are for campers at least 10 years old and at least 4' 6" tall (54 inches), with a maximum weight of 220 pounds. All riders must wear a helmet (provided), and no open-toed shoes or sandals. Any child age 10, 11 or 12 must register IN PERSON in THE OFFICE with a parent or guardian to verify minimum height requirement is met. The cost of a 30 minute guided trail ride is \$20.00, and you may sign up 1 day in advance for any morning trail rides, and same-day sign-ups are taken starting at 8AM for any remaining morning rides, as well as for that day's afternoon rides if the morning rides are filled. Be sure to meet at the corral 15 minutes prior to your riding time (the temporary equestrian center is located across from the main entrance, as the new barn is under construction)—THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR MISSED RIDES. Management reserves the right to reschedule rides due to weather. For the younger children, pony rides are offered for those riders at least 2 years of age, and are held in the show ring across from the entrance at 12:15PM—please be on time. You may purchase your \$2.50 tickets in the office anytime before 12:00PM. Due to insurance constraints, unfortunately we cannot offer pony rides to anyone under the age of 2, nor may we put 2 riders on a horse at any time. A parent must sign pony ride waiver and assurance of age at time of purchase, and must be present at pony rides, which use our full-size horses around the ring.

The activity schedule for the remainder of the week will be available on Monday.

Frisbee Golf--Visit our Disc Golf Course, located near the volleyball courts. This 9-hole course is great fun for any age. Our store carries discs designed specifically for disc golf, or you may bring your own. **NO PARKING ALONG ROAD**

The upstairs **Rec Center** is used for family ping-pong, billiards and movies. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Ping Pong equipment signed out with deposit. Due to insurance constraints, darts may not be signed out. Darts are available for purchase, as well as Ping Pong balls. Children's movies are also shown upstairs.

STRAWBERRY BARK...our fenced Pet Park! Please note that parking is located near Frisbee Golf (on the right side of Pierce Road, about 200 yards as you leave the main gate), with the crossing to the Pet Park directly across from the volleyball courts. Pets must be brought to the exercise facility in a vehicle—there is no walking of pets throughout the campground.

Our daily CHECK-OUT time is 12Noon, except on Sundays and holidays, when it is extended until 2:00PM (Summer Cabin, RV & Park Model Rental check-out time is 10:00AM). Daily CHECK-IN time is 1:00PM, except on Sundays and holidays, when it is 3:00PM (Rentals check in at 4PM each day). If you arrive prior to our scheduled check in time, or if you wish to remain beyond check-out, you are welcome to do so at no additional charge, provided that you park your vehicles and camping unit in the field across the street from our main entrance (do not block the horse path). You may not remain on site beyond check-out time, and there is no parking along roadsides, at the pool or in the Day Visitor Lot across from the softball field. RENTAL KEYS NOT RETURNED BY 10AM IMPEDE CLEANING AND MAY RESULT IN FORFEIT OF SECURITY DEPOSIT

Golf Cart rentals are now available (licensed drivers 21 & over only)...ask at the reservation desk about availability—be sure to read all rules carefully (such as no overloading of passengers—all occupants must be completely seated on a seat--no operation on roads outside of Strawberry Park and 8 MPH speed limit)

Wireless Internet

Strawberry Park's "Hotspot" reception is currently available throughout the Park. Campers receive an hour of free service per day. Additional time may be purchased in the office (\$1/hr; \$5/day; \$20/week or \$30/month). The construction materials used in RVs can limit reception—you will probably receive best results at your picnic table. Please note that your free hour each day starts when you first log on, and ends 60 minutes later (not 10 minutes now, 10 minutes later in the day etc). In addition, your free hour each day begins 24 hours after your previous day's free hour has ended.

Athletic equipment such as horseshoes, shuffleboard, or bocce may be signed out from the **ARCADE** with a \$20 deposit or a license. Please do not keep equipment for more than a few hours, as others may wish to use.

Local Fireworks Displays... (a reminder that the use of fireworks at Strawberry Park is prohibited, including sparklers)...On Saturday, July 3, the Norwich Tigers (Rookie League baseball team) will present a fireworks display at Dodd Stadium in the Norwich Industrial Park. To be perfectly honest, we are unsure of how well the logistics will be handled, as it has traditionally been at the Norwich Harbor...and the plan was for free advance tickets and \$5 parking. The town of Putnam will present a display on Friday, July 2 at 9:15PM (preceded by The Outriggers), and Killingly will also have fireworks on July 2 at Owen Bell Park. The annual Groton/New London fireworks will be held on Saturday, July 10.

Mud Wrestling sign up forms are available in the office. Due to the limited time and the vast number of sign ups, not everyone who wishes to enter will get a match. However, you can greatly increase your chances by completely filling out the permission/sign up form (this means including a tag team partner and 2 opponents). No forms will be accepted after 8PM Saturday. A list of matches will be posted on the office window by 1PM Sunday, and others who signed up may show up as alternates at the pit at 4:45PM. Action starts at 5PM.

BINGO NOTES

In accordance with Connecticut state statutes, 10% of the green card sales will benefit the posted non-profit sponsoring organization. As has always been the case, none of the money collected will be kept by Strawberry Park. Please note the following:

For \$1 per person, each player will receive:

1 (one) admission ticket*and 1 (one) brown card to be used for games 1-14 (prizes vary by game & crowd—see posted prize chart) EXTRA BROWN CARDS FOR GAMES 1-14 MAY BE PURCHASED FOR \$1 EACH (14 games usually take just over an hour)

If desired, players MAY purchase \$5 GREEN CARDS: Green cards to be used for the “winner take all” game #15 (a multi-part game) Prizes are determined based on 90% of all \$5 green “WTA” cards sold

- You do not need to buy any \$5 cards, but you must buy at least ONE \$1 brown card if you wish to play. You may not play ONLY the WTA game 15. No card sales (green or brown) after the start of game 8.
- ♦ players must be present to win, and each player may receive ONLY 1 ticket. Total number of Bingo players must equal ticket count. A player is someone old enough to play a card, present for the session.
- ♦ no admission tickets or additional cards will be sold after the start of game 8 (approx. 25 min after start)
- ♦ *Card sales begin approximately 30 minutes prior to posted start time*

Please note that there is NO SMOKING under the Rec Center. Smoking is permitted only at the picnic tables out on the patio. No glass bottles or open display of alcohol.

Single Stream Recycling and Separation in effect for 2010

Each arriving camper will receive two different trash bags upon registration. The black bag (or you may use your own trash bags, such as “Hefty”...as long as they are NOT CLEAR) is for true “trash”, which is simply defined as anything that is NOT included on the list of recyclables below. The CLEAR TRASH BAG is for all items that are able to be recycled. There is no need to separate the plastics from the metals from the paper etc. Please place your tied bags roadside between the hours of 8AM and 4PM daily, and Strawberry Park will take your trash AND recyclables to the appropriate dumpster. **DO NOT PLACE TRASH OUT AFTER DARK!!!** As we are located out in the country, your trash may attract various forms of wildlife, including (but not limited to) raccoons, skunks, squirrels, mice and fox. **What can be placed in the clear recycle bags?** The following items may all be placed in the same clear bag—no need to separate: Paper, rinsed plastic bottles & jugs & jars (#1-#7 plastics), newspapers, magazines & brochures, paperbacks & phone books, rinsed glass bottles & jars, metal jar lids (removed from the jar), cans, paper egg cartons, paper milk & juice cartons (remove caps), paperboard boxes, paper bags, corrugated cardboard, empty aerosol cans. **What can't go in?** Food waste (please rinse containers), bio-hazardous waste & needles, basic trash, as well as “dirty paper”, such as pizza boxes. These items should all be placed in your black trash bag. Need more bags? Just ask!

New Early Bird Reservation Opportunity!!

We hope you are enjoying your current stay at Strawberry Park. Many of you are familiar with trying to make reservations on our “reservations’ opening day” of January 2 of each year. To better serve our camper’s request to reserve earlier, we are offering the opportunity to make reservations one year in advance. This will be permitted for summer vacation stays, as well as for spring and fall weekends. Therefore, you are now able to reserve a spot for 2011 comparable dates (if you are looking to make a 2011 summer reservation for a 7-night stay or longer), before heading home. Anyone reserving during the 2010 camping season and making their required deposit will receive 2011 rates at 2010 prices.
